

FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE

We are passionate about supporting families during a challenging time and love what we do. In order to provide a high quality service, we need to dedicate time to our patients and offer long consultations to give you and your family the care you deserve. Unfortunately, the Medicare Rebate has increased minimally over the last 20 years, and more importantly, it has never properly funded longer, more complex appointments. The Medicare Rebate is currently disproportionate to the cost of providing high level care. For this reason, all consults at Adelaide Mums and Babies Clinic will incur out of pocket costs (a gap payment). Our clinic does not offer bulk-billed consults. This applies to children, pensioners, health care card holders, students, and patients that may have previously been bulk-billed by us. Full payment is required to be paid on the day of the consultation. Any delayed payments may incur an additional payment such as an admin fee.

If a Medicare rebate can be applied to the consult (which occurs in the vast majority of cases), this rebate can be instant on the day or will be transferred into your nominated bank account within 48 hours depending on your account. Out of pocket costs apply to face-to-face, telehealth and telephone appointments.

For newborns, we highly recommend completing their Medicare card application on-line as soon as possible after their birth. If you do not have a valid Medicare card for them at the time of the consult, the full payment will be required to be made on the day, and you can apply for the Medicare rebate from Medicare directly, at a later date.

At Adelaide Mums and Babies Clinic, we are committed to providing care to all patients, regardless of their Medicare status.

Please note that, unfortunately, we are unable to process private health insurance claims at the clinic. If you do not have Medicare, you are welcome to make a claim directly with your private health insurer, where applicable. Private health insurance generally does not provide cover for standard consultations with doctors outside of a hospital setting. Depending on your policy, some Allied Health services may be covered. If you have any questions regarding your eligibility for rebates, we recommend contacting your private health insurer directly.

Please contact us to discuss payment of your account prior to your consultation, if you feel you will have trouble paying the full amount on the day.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Appointment reminders are sent out automatically through our software 48 hours in advance, allowing you up to 24 hours to cancel or reschedule an appointment before our 24 hour cancellation policy applies.

Appointments:

A cancellation fee will apply if there is failure to give 24 hours notice of appointment cancellation. The cancellation fee will be the out of pocket fee for the type of consultation that was booked. Please review our financial disclosure for the fees associated with cancellations.

If you complete an online booking you are agreeing and acknowledging the 24 hour cancellation policy.

Classes: Antenatal Breastfeeding Education Class & Bringing Baby Home Class & Circle of Security
Cancellations over 48 hours will receive full reimbursement. Cancellations under 48 hours will receive a 50% refund.

Parents Group:

Cancellations of the entire 6 week block (if cancelled prior to class 1). Cancellations under 24 hours have an \$88 fee. Cancellations over 24 hours will receive a full refund.

DID NOT ATTEND (DNA) POLICY

If you do not attend a booked appointment or have not cancelled the appointment outside of the 24 hours a fee will apply. The Did not attend fee will be the out of pocket fee for the type of consultation that was booked. Please review our financial disclosure for the fees associated with a did not attend fee.

FEE SCHEDULE

Please note – **the below tables indicate the OUT OF POCKET (or GAP) payment ONLY.** The total amount payable will be significantly more, depending on what Medicare Item numbers we can use, which many are time based. In many instances, the total amount payable will be at least double. **Gaps will increase depending on the time spent with the doctor.**

NIPPLE LASER

An initial GP or lactation consultation is required prior to treatment to determine your treatment plan

BREASTFEEDING, UNSETTLED INFANT, SLEEP, POOR WEIGHT GAIN, TONGUE TIE ASSESSMENT & SNIP

Parent and baby are both seen in the 60 min appointment. The child is bulk billed. Parents have the gap applied to their account. If the baby does not have a valid Medicare Card or not yet registered, full payment for their component of the consult is required on the day and the parent is responsible for submitting the claim to Medicare once the Medicare card has been received. This may be as much as an additional \$160.

HOME VISITS – BREASTFEEDING AND INFANT SUPPORT

Parent and baby are both seen in the 60 min appointment. The baby is bulk billed. Parents have the gap applied to their account. If the baby does not have a valid Medicare Card, full payment for their component of the consultation is required on the day. This may be as much as an additional \$160.

EDUCATION CLASSES

These classes are a private group & are run by either a GP IBCLC or our Possums Peer Support Worker who is trained in the Possums approach to breastfeeding, unsettled infants and sleep. All classes do not attract a Medicare Rebate and require full payment at the time of booking. **Some private health funds cover a Lactation consultations with a Lactation Consultant (IBCLC), please check with your health fund prior to your consultation and notify our team when booking that you require a tax invoice for private health by an IBCLC**

FACILITY FEES

Some procedures performed at AMBC require additional clinical time, nursing support, specialised equipment and/or medical consumables. To help cover these costs, an additional private procedure fee may apply alongside the consultation fee.

These procedure fees are not eligible for a Medicare rebate and will vary depending on the procedure and the level of support required.

Where possible, our team will let you know about any additional fees prior to your procedure so that you are aware of the expected costs.

Payment Terms
